As you are aware from a recent CALR e-Blast, the new "Unlicensed Activity Action Unit" (UAAU) is up and running. Now it is our part to become involved in the process. I was asked to extend a request to our members to report information and incidents of unlicensed activity in hopes of attracting the support of local District Attorneys throughout California to pursue and prosecute violators. Chief Trujillo stated that she would be meeting with a District Attorney in San Joaquin County this week and another in San Diego County in the near future.
